## Japan Hands Over New Cargo/Passenger Vessel to Tuvalu

The Government of Japan has provided a new cargo/passenger vessel, the 'Nivaga III' worth AU\$18 million to the Government of Tuvalu. H.E. Mr. Takuji Hanatani, Ambassador of Japan, will hand over the above-mentioned vessel to the Acting Prime Minister, Hon. Maatia Toafa at a ceremony to be held at Funafuti Port in Tuvalu at 08:00 am, on Wednesday, 9 December 2015.

## Details for the Project for Construction of a Cargo/Passenger Vessel

1. Basis for Implementing the Project

This project is implemented under Japan's Grant Aid Programme. The main aim of this project is to enhance inter-island shipping in Tuvalu as a major component of the overall development of the country. There are 9 main atolls in Tuvalu but there is no domestic airline for inter-island routes. Sea transport is therefore very important for Tuvalu.

Based on such importance, Japan built the new cargo/passenger vessel to improve access not only to islands within Tuvalu but also for calling at ports internationally.
