

## Rolling Plan for the Republic of Fiji

As of April, 2014

[Diplomatic Consideration, etc.]

In line with the Principles of ODA Implementation in Japan's Official Development Assistance Charter, assistance to Fiji focuses on the following areas and projects, paying due consideration to the progress in Fiji toward democratization; (1) contributing to the improvement of people's lives such as education, health and support for social vulnerable groups, (2) addressing global issues such as environmental conservation and infectious diseases control, (3) initiating necessary surveys and assessments for possible future collaborations and implementation of Infrastructure Projects contributing to nation building and (4) regional cooperation based on Fiji, being the hub of Pacific will not only benefit Fiji through the areas mentioned from (1) to (4) above but also benefit other Pacific Island Countries through the implementation of such projects.

[Development Issue]  Environment Conservation	[Background] In the Pacific region, the amount of waste is increasing due to modern lifestyle dependence on imported goods and the present waste disposal system not functioning appropriately. Waste management is a common issue in the region, and some improvements achieved through Japanese cooperation in Samoa and Vanuatu have been introduced into other countries in the region. In the Pacific Island countries, natural environment is an important resource for tourism and other sectors, hence establishing an appropriate waste management system and a sustainable natural resource management system is a critical issue. Furthermore, as a primary industry, fisheries requires measures to address resource degradation and sustainable use of resources.					[Japan's Assistance policy] Coordinating with regional organization such as South Pacific Regional Environment Programme (SPREP), the Ministry of Environment and municipalities in Japan, Japan provides assistance to establish a comprehensive and integrated waste management system and to elaborate regional waste disposal plan. Japan also provides assistance to develop coastal resource management techniques through dispatching JICA experts and volunteers.

[Development Issue]  Sustainable Economic Development	[Background] Whilst rural areas and outer islands provide the main resources of agriculture, marine products, minerals and the tourism industry, the insufficiency of human resource development and infrastructure in such areas leads to population flow from rural to urban areas and a growing number of squatter settlements, which is a great concern for Fiji. Well-balanced sustainable development of urban and rural areas requires improvement in the living standards and human resource development for sustainable livelihoods. It requires measures to address resource degradation.			[Japan's Assistance policy] Japan provides assistance for sea transportation maintenance and protection of the environment with respect to deep sea minerals exploration, by dispatching experts. Japan also provides assistance for improving livelihoods in rural and outer islands mainly by dispatching volunteers.
