<u>Japan Hands Over Emergency Relief Assistance to Fiji in the</u> <u>Aftermath of Tropical Cyclone Winston</u>

The Government of Japan is providing Emergency Relief Assistance in the aftermath of Tropical Cyclone Winston, worth 19 million Japanese Yen, (approximately 170,000 USD), to Fiji through the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA). The emergency relief items consist of tents (440), plastic sheets (120), sleeping pads (420), generators (25), and Code Reel with Generator (25). Mr. Kinzo Nakagun, Chargé d'Affaires a.i. of the Embassy of Japan will hand over Japan's Emergency Relief Assistance to Mr. Manasa Tagicakibau, Commissioner Western, at 11:00am on Saturday, 27 February 2016, at the Nadi International Airport.
