Details of the Project for Provision of Garbage Truck to South Tarawa

1. Basis for Implementing the Project

The timely assistance of the garbage truck will boost the Council's solid waste collection operations. Currently, Teinainano Urban Council (TUC) hires three open trucks to ensure waste collection schedule is aptly covered. However, this option is not economically viable for the Council and it poses occupational, health and safety risks to the garbage collectors and the public.

The provision of the garbage truck will improve waste management operations of TUC by providing an efficient, hazard free and timely waste collection service to the residents of South Tarawa.
