Japan Formalizes Grant for Provision of Medical Equipment to Fiji

The Government of Japan will provide assistance worth 500 million Japanese Yen (approximately FJ\$10 million) to the Government of the Republic of Fiji through its Economic Social Development Programme (ESDP). The funding assistance will enable the procurement of equipment to support the efficient delivery of health and medical services in Fiji.

Hon. Dr. Ifereimi Waqainabete, Minister for Health and Medical Services, and H.E. Mr. Masahiro Omura, Ambassador of Japan, will formalise Japan's assistance to Fiji at Signing and Exchange of Notes Ceremony hosted by the <u>Ministry of Health and</u> <u>Medical Services, at Main Conference Room, at 11:00 AM, on Monday, 29</u> June 2020.

Details of the Project for Procurement of Medical Equipment

- 1) The Government of the Republic Fiji will receive 500 Million Japanese Yen (App FJ\$10M) for the procurement various medical equipment to support health and medical service delivery. Fiji reported its first COVID-19 case on 19 March 2020 and since then Fiji has been working progressively to prevent the spread of this virus. Apart from dealing the pandemic, Fiji has suffered severe damage by tropical cyclone Harold and that has exacerbated other health challenges such as leptospirosis, dengue fever, diarrhoea and typhoid (LDDT) in communities. The proactive measures taken by the Fiji Government has resulted in Fiji being declared COVID-19 free.
- 2) The grant will enable the Ministry of Health and Medical Services to procure necessary medical equipment and accessories. The procurement will be assisted by Japan International Cooperation Systems (JICS). This grant assistance supports Fiji's National Development Plan 2017-2036, which focuses on providing quality and affordable health care to the people of Fiji.
- 3) The Government of Japan has supported to the Ministry of Health through assistances such as the dispatch of experts and volunteers in the areas like non-communicable diseases (NCDs) and total quality management (5S Kaizen), and the implementation of infrastructure projects like the construction of Fiji School of Nursing (1984-1985, US\$8.2M), the redevelopment of Fiji School of Medicine and CWM Hospital (1991-1992, US\$16.2M), the construction of a pediatric unit at CWM Hospital (1998, US\$10.7M) and the construction of the Fiji Pharmaceutical Service Center (2001-2003, US\$8.8M).
