Good Afternoon, Ekamowir omo, and Konichiwa to you all.

Firstly, I wish to convey my sincere appreciation for the warm hospitality extended to me and my colleagues since our arrival in Nauru. And I thank Mrs. Chanda Garabwan, and the respective Nauru officials for hosting this Handing over Ceremony for the "Project for Provision of Medical Equipments".

On behalf of the Government and people of Japan, I take this opportunity to congratulate His Excellency Mr. Russ Kun, on his successful election as the President of Nauru. It is indeed an honor to work with the new Government, and I look forward to further strengthening relations between our two countries through a closer partnership.

Over the years, Japan has been providing continued assistance to Nauru Under the ESDP scheme. Japan supported the Government of Nauru in various areas such as Fisheries, with the provision of 'Aquaculture Equipment', Transport, the provision of medical equipment to the Republic of Nauru Hospital in 2018 and equipment and machinery for sustainable waste management, to name a few.

Congratulations once again on receiving these equipment. I sincerely hope that with proper care and timely maintenance, these items will diligently serve the people of Nauru for many years ahead.

I conclude with confidence that this Grant Aid will further strengthen friendship shared between the people and governments of Nauru and Japan.
