The Government of Japan provided FJD \$134,540 to Toga District School for the construction of a new 7-pan Wash facility, under Japan's Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP) Programme. Details for The Project for Improving Sanitation Environment of Toga District School

1. Basis for Implementing the Project

Since 1987, Toga District School has endured many challenges such as lack of proper sanitation and an adequate ablution facility for the students and teachers. In addition, not only was the old ablution crowded with students all the time, its condition kept deteriorating until it became non- compliant with the Occupational Health and Safety standards in Fiji.

For that reason, the Government of Japan funded the construction of a new 7-pan ablution facility. This facility will improve the health and sanitation of the school and its students.

2. Basic Information

(a) Donor: Government of Japan(b) Recipient: Toga District School

(c) Total funding: FJ\$134,540 (US\$67,744)

The GGP Programme is part of the overall Japanese ODA implemented by the Embassy of Japan in order to empower the people at the grassroots level. The GGP Programme in Fiji has been widely implemented in areas such as education, water supply, health and transportation since 1990. To date, 421 projects have been funded for under the GGP Programme that amount to an approximate value of USD \$32 million.
