I. Basis for Implementing the Project

Over the past years, the school roll had increased drastically without the necessary school infrastructure expansion and improvement. In addition, the deteriorating conditions of old classrooms has created an unsafe learning environment for the students.

For that reason, the Government of Japan funded the construction of a new 1x3 classroom block, desks and chairs. This facility will aim improve education and provide a better learning environment for the students.
