- Reporting: Prepare high-quality reports on security and defense in Fiji and Pacific Island Countries.
- Stakeholder Engagement: Build and maintain networks and strategic relationships with key partners.

What We're Looking For:

- Qualifications: A university degree in security studies, international relations, or a related field. It would be an added advantage if you are conversant with the defence and security issues of the wider Pacific region.
- Experience: Working experience in security, diplomacy, government or related fields in the area defence and security is preferable.
- Strong organizational skills: Ability to prioritize, multitask, maintain accuracy and effectively meet deadlines.
- Communication Proficiency: Produce clear and well-structured written documents in English. Interact effectively with a diverse range of stakeholders and partners at various levels.
- Collaborative and Independent: Strong ability to produce results as a team player while being able to perform with minimum supervision.
